LISA, Inc. is a private, 501c3 non-profit organization providing services to young people throughout the state of Connecticut for over 45 years.

Our service population is focused on adolescent girls and boys in foster care, who are survivors of abuse, neglect and human trafficking, from cities and towns throughout Connecticut. Services are located in Bristol, Southington and Plainville. Our young people range in age from 14-23.

LISA, Inc. receives funding on a fee-for-service basis from the State of Connecticut Department of Children and Families and grants from local organizations and businesses to cover the cost of providing shelter, food, clothing, and support services to our residents. It is only through the generosity of our supporters and donors that we are able to provide extracurricular activities that improve the quality of life and meet the complex needs of the young people we serve.

Programs

Lisa's Wish - Plainville

A Supportive Work, Education, and Transition program for young women, age 17-21. We provide a safe, stable 8-bed program for girls aging out of foster care. Weekly opportunities for skill development, educational support, and support in healing from trauma are the focus. Our girls have a history of abuse, neglect, human trafficking and have experienced multiple placements throughout their lives. Lisa's Wish helps girls build a foundation for a successful future.

SAIL Program - Bristol

Transitional program for young adults working toward independence, including expectant moms and parenting youth. SAIL offers one and two bedroom apartments and provides 24/7 staff support. This program serves DCF-referred young adults who require support as they make the transition to adulthood. Our youth are supported as they attend school, enroll in vocational programs or higher education, and/or explore job opportunities.

CBLS

The Community Based Life Skills (CBLS) program is facilitated with youth in a one-on-one setting to help them develop and enhance essential life skills. The youth in this program live in foster homes and are looking to transition successfully into adulthood. Through an extensive individual life skills assessment, and experiential, one-to-one learning approaches, youth are taught skills that will assist them in their transition from DCF care to self-sufficiency.

Youth Excellence Program

A program for adolescent boys ages 13-15 who are in foster or congregate care who participate in two half-day workshops a month leading up to a weeklong trip. The mission is to empower youth who have endured significant life challenges to experience success, navigate life obstacles and emerge as adults.
