L. I. S. A. is a private, non-profit agency providing services to abused, neglected, abandoned and adjudicated youth from throughout the state of Connecticut for over 40 years. Our Agency operates the following programs in Connecticut:

Beacon House, Wolcott

Opened in 1976 in Waterbury and relocated to Wolcott in 1993, Beacon House is an 8 bed group home for adolescent females ages 13-21.

Plainville Group Home, Plainville

Founded in 1970, PGH is a ten bed home serving adolescent females ages 13-21, who reside and receive treatment in order to recuperate from the abuse, neglect and other trauma in their lives.

S.A.I.L. Program, Bristol

Our Supervised Apartments for Independent Living (est. 1993) is an eight bed apartment program assisting adolescents and teen moms to prepare for their transition into adulthood and equips them with the skills necessary for successful independent living.

CLS Program, Waterbury

Our Community Life Skills Program (est. 1989) offers a structured classroom program to DCF Youth ages 16-21. The purpose of the program is to increase their knowledge base of lifeskills in order to successfully transition into adulthood and independent living.

Stitch Together, Plainville

A Stitch in Time (est. 2003) is a vocational training program for adolescents, who learn job skills by operating a manufacturing and retail knitting business and online yarn shop.

Connections Mentoring Program

Connections Mentoring matches individual mentors and mentor families with adolescents residing in LISA Inc. residential programs.

How is L.I.S.A. Funded?

L.I.S.A., Inc. receives 95% of its funding from the State of Connecticut on a fee for service or grant basis. The balance comes from the local United Ways of Greater Waterbury and Hartford, local, state, federal grants, fundraisers and from the generosity of individual and group donors who make it possible for L.I.S.A., Inc. to operate and meet the complex array of needs of the youth we serve.

Whom Do We Serve?

L.I.S.A., Inc. serves the needs of children and youth who need out of home placements for a wide range of reasons including abuse, neglect, abandonment, and various family traumas. Our youth primarily come from the Greater Waterbury, New Britain and Hartford areas, but also from all corners of the state. Our group homes and vocational program service females, ages 12 to 20. The CLS program is for both male and female age 16-21 while SAIL serves females, teen moms and their children

Where Will These Proceeds Go?

Proceeds will go towards improving the quality of life for residents by providing extra curricular, recreational and cultural activities, educational materials and an array of new activities with community inclusion.
